A big thing in life is 'where are you from'? We say 'your accent betrays you'. Sometimes we judge totally on where people are from, as Pilate with Jesus. With all he knew of him and heard, the miracles and the speeches, he asks Where are you from? Are you a king really?

What sort is your kingdom?

Pilate was intrigued with Jesus and so are we.
